Insurance Fraud Investigation Request Per NRS 686A.

Our Investigation Request Form **MUST** be used when submitting any referrals on suspicious claims, which might involve insurance fraud. Please follow these instructions:

- 1) Print out the blank form from the website and fill out completely giving all pertinent information as to why the claim is suspicious. You **CANNOT** and we **WILL NOT ACCEPT** electronic transmissions of the form.
- 2) Please type or print legibly.
- 3) Please be sure to indicate who the claimant is if other than the insured.
- 4) Please indicate if the referral is for "Information Only".
- 5) Please forward the original completed form to:


